

Townspeople displayed their crafts and trades.










SERGE RAMELLI MEETING SUMMARY

When naming your picture during upload, please include your phone model in the title, as we think it would be very interesting to see the various types of phones used.

We are excited to have this category as a competition theme for the first time, as phone cameras have become a convenient way to document life and create art in our society. Photographers say that the best camera is the one you have with you, and that would certainly apply to cell phones, which are much easier to carry around than large DSLRs.

"Phonography" uses the same principles of light, color and composition as regular photography, but each phone varies in the features it has related to the camera. Enjoy playing with those features. Try new apps like Snapseed, VSCO, Tiny Planet, Afterlight2, Adobe Lightroom, Aviary, and Prisma, to edit your photos.
